## **Contest Purpose**

## **Contest Deadline**

DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES IS **MAY 1, 2019**

## **Entry Details**

- Contest is for public, private and home school MD students in grades K-12. Creativity and color are encouraged in student's original artwork.
- Artwork entered in the contest should feature Maryland Agriculture. The calendar will highlight the diversity of agriculture throughout our state.
- MEDIA SHOULD BE MARKER, CRAYON, WATERCOLOR, INK, ACRYLIC, TEMPERA PAINT or COLORED PENCIL. No pastels, chalk, or pencil drawings will be accepted.
- Entries must be 8.5 by 11 inches and HORIZONTAL (landscape) orientation (NOT vertical).
- Entries must be on paper that will allow for duplication, scanning and display. Entries must be flat, NOT folded, matted, mounted, laminated or framed. The use of cartoon characters or TV figures is not acceptable.
- Submissions should be all pictures NO words.
- An official entry blank or copy MUST be completed and securely attached to the back of each entry. (Please duplicate forms as needed.) Make sure each entry form is filled out completely and that writing is legible.
- Entries should be mailed to:

- All entries will become the property of the Maryland Agricultural Education Foundation and will not be returned. Maryland Agricultural Education Foundation reserves the right to publish the entries in future publications and promotions without additional compensation.
