Contest Purpose

DEADLINE FOR ENTRIES IS **MAY 1, 2019**

Entry Details

- Contest is for public, private and home school MD students in grades K-12. Creativity and color are encouraged in student's original artwork.
- Artwork entered in the contest should feature Maryland Agriculture. The calendar will highlight the diversity of agriculture throughout our state.
- MEDIA SHOULD BE MARKER, CRAYON, WATERCOLOR, INK, ACRYLIC, TEMPERA PAINT or COLORED PENCIL. No pastels, chalk, or pencil drawings will be accepted.
- Entries must be 8.5 by 11 inches and **HORIZONTAL** (landscape) orientation (**NOT** vertical).
- Entries must be on paper that will allow for duplication, scanning and display. Entries must be flat, **NOT** folded, matted, mounted, laminated or framed. The use of cartoon characters or TV figures is not acceptable.
- Submissions should be all pictures **NO** words.
- An official entry blank or copy **MUST** be completed and securely attached to the back of each entry. (Please duplicate forms as needed.) Make sure each entry form is filled out completely and that writing is legible.
