



Slice Open the Parts of an Apple

Discover and create a fun model to show the parts of an apple!

Materials:

- 1 piece of construction paper, any color
- 1 small paper plate
- 1 set of “Parts of an Apple” labels (see pg. 2)
- Red, green, and brown crayon, marker, or crayon
- Glue
- Scissors

Instructions:

1. Read about apples [here](https://tinyurl.com/y2tz4dac). <https://tinyurl.com/y2tz4dac>
2. Cut two “slices” out of opposite sides of the plate so the shape you’re left with resembles an hourglass. Save one of the “slices”.
3. Color the top and bottom border of your hourglass plate red.
4. Draw several seeds in the uncolored center of the plate.
5. Cut the saved “slice” of plate into a small leaf shape and color it green.
6. Glue your apple to your paper and draw a brown stem coming from the top.
7. Add the leaf to the top by the stem.
8. Cut apart your labels and match them to each apple part.
