Getting Started



- Read the official rules before beginning.
- Brainstorm ideas. Choose a subject or topic for your artwork that highlights what makes Maryland agriculture special. Remember that your artwork must be your original idea, and not copied from other works of art.
- Choose the media you will use: marker, crayon, watercolor, ink, tempera paint, or colored pencil. (No pastels, chalk, or pencil-only drawings will be accepted.)
- Think about how you can use color throughout your artwork, including the background.

Creating Your Agricultural Art

- Create your art on 8.5 x 11-inch paper in horizontal/landscape orientation. Entries must be on paper that will allow for scanning and display.
- Your artwork should consist of pictures only.
