



2022 Seibel Scholarship Guidelines

Purpose

To assist those students requiring financial support who are pursuing a career in agriculture.

Scholarship Award

- One or more \$1,000 awards annually
- May be awarded more than once to same individual
- Application reviews and awards made by the MAEF Secondary Education Committee

Selection Criteria

Residency

Applicant must be a resident of the State of Maryland

Qualifying Institutions

- Institute of Applied Agriculture (1st Preference)
- University of Maryland (2nd Preference)
- Other, in or out of state, institutions offering an accredited Agriculture program.

Award Priority – Eligible Agricultural Paths of Study

- Two-year certificate program (1st Preference)
- Four-year undergraduate program with interest in teaching
- Graduate program - continuing teacher education

Selection Criteria	Points
Documented Financial Need	40
Academic Record	20
Demonstrated Leadership & Community Service	20
Agricultural Background & Career Goals Rural Background (5) Career Goals (15)	20
Total:	100
